This super shearling was later sold for £900, it was however the Reserve Champion from KJ & CS Wilson which topped the sale at £1600.

The MV section was equally WELL competed in and the Champion was eventually selected from CR Fawcett, Well House with a Beltex X and this realised £700 at sale time. Top Price for the MV section went to G Pyman, Park View with a super Dutch Texel which sold for £1000.
