Judge Mike Dixon had the difficult task of choosing a Champion but eventually it was a 2nd calver from Andrew Carter of Gerrard House Farm Ltd that took honours in the Shire Leasing sponsored show. This 50kg cow having given 9500kg as a heifer met spirited bidding before being secured by the judge for £2,100. Friesian types to £1850 for a smart 2nd calver from Nerewater Farms.

The production sale from How End Farms met an excellent trade strong from the outset as buyers were keen to secure milk from strong productive cattle. Several over £2000 to a top of £2250 for a half Norwegian Red X Talent 30kg heifer. At £2150 was the 1st placed heifer and this stylish black heifer again subject to strong levels of interest. 2nd and 3rd lactation cows in severe demand with £1950 reached on three occasions for cows giving 40kg plus.
