Anniversary Show & Sale of Primestock

Prime Cattle – 53

The 7th Anniversary Show and Sale was well supported and one of the best entries of cattle on a Tuesday sale for some considerable time, with trade very strong throughout.

The champion heifer was consigned by Mr John Dixon (Jnr) of Lessonhall and this super 625kg heifer finding plenty of buyer support before being sold at 258.5p/kg to family butcher, Mr Steven Wilson for his Corby Hill shop. Reserve champion from Messrs Miller, High Aketon was a super 632kg heifer and this realised 245.5p/kg.

Top Bullock selling for D A Harrison and this 721kg Limousin bullock reaching £1625 to B & T Kitson Ltd Butchers, Hutton Rugby.

Top gross of the day was for a 723kg Limousin heifer from J Dixon & Son, Lessonhall, reaching £1753
