Overall sale average 326p/kg and an SQQ average of 333p. Commercial type hogs sold away well between 275p/kg and 300p/kg and anything smart making 350p/kg plus. Overall price per head averaged an impressive £140.20.





Sale top today was £190 for a tremendous 51kg Beltex from Messrs Watson, Cuningarth. Top price per kg was 457.7p for a 39kg Beltex for R.E Miller, West Farm, Aspatria.
