Top Bullock reaching 257.5pkg for a 641kg Limousin from RE Miller, West Farm, which also reached the top gross price at £1650.58. Top gross in Heifers reached £1697.22 for a British Blue, weighing 756kg from J Dixon & Sons Ltd, Lesson Hall, which was purchased by local butcher Paul Harrison for his King Street shop.
