The largest show of store lambs at Wigton for some time and what a trade to match with a fit ringside of buyers, with trade electric right to the very last pen through the ring with a phenomenal sale average of £111.33!

The Show was kindly and expertly judged by Mr Andrew Phillips, Fir Trees Farm, Harrogate. He selected his champions a wonderful pen of 10 Blue Texels from Messrs Fell, Stanger Hill, Torpenhow which went on to top the sale selling for £162 per head which is the highest price achieved for store lambs this season! The consignment of well bred and expertly presented Blue Texel lambs from Stanger Hill averaged a staggering £134.41 for 163.

Second Prize pen of 10 went to a cracking pen of Beltex wethers from Messrs T & J Airey, New Grange which fell at the hammer at £150 per head. Third Prize pen of 10 went to another consignor for top quality sheep Messrs KD & ME Harryman, Keskadale, Newlands which sold for £151 per head.

Well bred classy lambs both short and long keep sold exceptionally well easily making £115 to £140

Plainer type lambs were also a lot sharper with very few of this type going for under £80 regularly cashing between £80-£90.
