

A fantastic entry of lambs for the time in the season and a wonderful show of quality. The sale topped at £170 per head twice, firstly for a pair of cracking shaped Beltex ewe lambs from G.E.H & S.J Stoddart, Hillside and secondly for a pair of smart Beltex crosses from M. Bindloss & Son, Shap Abbey. Thanks to the show of quality the sale averaged a staggering £125.32 which is the highest sale average achieved all season at Hopes Auction.

M. Bindloss & Son, Shap Abbey sold the last of their large consignments of store lambs selling 286 Beltex lambs to average £129.42 per head. This consignment along with some other great shows of lambs attracted a ringside of buyers from all over the country keen to get their hands on the quality stock produced in this area.
