Trade from start to finish was steadier as a knock-on effect to the Prime Ring.

Top price of the day was paid for a Beltex weather from Messrs Richardson, Low Garth, Bewaldeth and sold to £150, with their second pen also selling for £138.

The first prized pen of 10 continental lambs from Messrs Wood went on to sell for a very respectable £130, which sold to the Judge on behalf of Mr T Mason, East Farm, Malton. The second pen from Well Head was a pen of 11 also selling for a very respectable £132, with their run of 42 lambs averaging £128.45
