Another cracking show of Calves and Stirks, with equal quantity of both sorts available, to suit the packed ringside of buyers, with the buyers favouring the British Blues today.

Topping today at £720, a cracking pair of 10-month-old British Blue Steer Stirks from Messrs JB & EJ Peile Ltd, Greystoke Castle Farm, closely followed by another pair of 10-month-old British Blue Heifers selling to £720 from the same home. Messrs JB & EJ Peile Ltd also topped the leading averages, selling 10 to a tremendous average of £724 50

Messrs RG & W Whitfield also sold 4-month-old British Blue Bulls to £600 with his average topping out at £528.13 for 8.

Nice to see regular vendor Norman Eilbeck, Plumbland Farm, back on top form, topping the Calf section with a 3-month-old British Blue Heifer selling to £465, and his average of £350.83 for 12 calves being reached.

The lovely warm weather put the buyers in good form, setting the trade on fire and leaving the vendors ecstatic with their trade.

The Quarterly Show and Sale of Dairy Cows and Heifers was very aptly judged by Karl Stephenson, High Pow, who after much deliberation placed his Champion to Lot no 58, the first placed Cow, a tremendous 2nd Calved Holstein Friesian Cow, giving 46 litres, with a low cell count and gave 8500litres as a Heifer, from Messrs Carter, Gerrard House Farm Ltd, which later sold to £2300.

Reserve Champion was placed to the first placed Heifer, a fantastic strong May Calving Heifer, giving 32 litres, 4.56% Butter Fat, 3.21% Protein and a Cell Count of 16, which later sold to £2300 from JA Martin Farms Ltd, Orton Grange Farm.

Topping today, again from JA Martin Farms Ltd, Orton Grange, Lot no 52, a May Calving Red Holstein Friesian Heifer, giving 31 litres, 4.07% Butter Fat, 3.11% Protein and a Cell Count of 26, selling to a very respectable £2700.

3rd Calved Cows sold to £1700 for a 10-week calved, half Norwegian Red Cow, giving 48ltrs with 5.00% Butter Fat and 3.3% Protein.

Messrs J & I Watson & Son, Moor House Farm sold a cracking run of three May Calved Heifers to £1900 and averaged £1833.33.


