The pre-sale show was very ably judged by Mr Edwin Holliday, Cleamire and after much deliberation, for the third year in a row, the 'Edwin Holliday Memorial Trophy' was awarded to Chris Pears, Fellside House Farm, Caldbeck and these sheep later sold to £230 at sale time.
