The sale of Calves and Stirks was predominately made up of young Calves today, which sold to a top of £405 for a 10-week-old British Blue Bull Calf from CP & JA Brough, West Park Farm, Crofton, whose run of 3 calves went on to average £365. Regular vendor Messrs Eilbeck & Son, Plumbland Farm had a fantastic run of 10 British Blue Bull and Heifer Calves and averaged a very respectable £314, this consignment sold to a top of £380 for a 12-week-old Bull Calf and his Heifer calves topped the young heifer calves at £320.

Twelve-week-old Aberdeen Angus Bull Calves sold to £325 for a pen of two for JN & WB & AN Carruthers, East Farm, Cross Cannonby, while 12-week-old Angus Heifer calves sold to £300 for a pen of two from Tarnrigg Ltd, Tarnrigg Moor, with their run of 8 Calves selling to an average of £359.38.

Stirks topped at £770 for a cracking 7-month-old British Blue Steer from Messrs GN Hetherington, Crookdake House, who also sold 7-month-old British Blue Heifer Stirks to £740, this same good farming home took the top average spot of the day at £756.67 for three animals sold.

Dairy Bred British Blue Stirks sold to a top of £520 for four-month-old Bulls from RG & W Whitfield Ltd, Balladoyle Farm, Silloth.
