PRIME LAMBS – 983

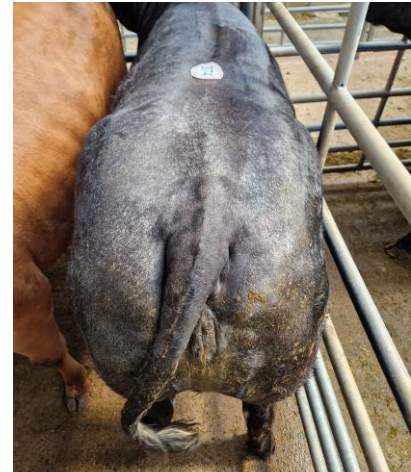
Another good show of Lambs forward, pleasing to see greater numbers forward to take advantage of the trade. All
