A super show of Calves and Stirks and a growing ringside of buyers ensured an electric trade for all classes to a top of £810 for a seven-month-old Limousin Bullock Stirk from Messrs Christie, Rheda Close, Frizington, closely followed at £800 by another Limousin Bullock from Messrs Carr, New House Farm, Beckfoot. Heifers also good to sell with Blues to £720 also from Messrs Carr, Beckfoot. British Blue Bull Stirks to £775 for Messrs GN Hetherington, Crookdake House and Charollais Bull Stirks to £735 for Steven Wilson, Corby Hill.

Younger types in short supply and finding ready homes with four-month-old Limousin Bulls to £640 for Messrs Christie, Rheda Close and £600 on two occasions, firstly for Messrs Whitfield, Balladoyle Farm, and secondly for JW Briggs, Southerfield Hall.

Five-month-old Limousin Heifers to £695 for Messrs Christie, Rheda Close and £610 for Blues and Limousins from Messrs Whitfield, Balladoyle Farm.

Milk Calves at extreme rates to £460 for five-week-old Blues from Messrs Bailey, Moorhouse Hall Farm, who also had a cracking one month old Angus to £415. Six-week-old Blue Heifers to £365 for Graham Farms, Greenrigg, and Limousin Calves from the same home also to £365.

STORE LAMBS - 2207

Thursday 12th October, Hopes held their fortnightly sale of Store Lambs with a bumper show of 2207 sheep forward. All classes of sheep were forward, with a larger run of commercial sheep and a trade to dominate all other outlets.

Top price of the day was achieved by Hewson and Tracey Wood, Well Head Farm, Dean, topping the day at a staggering £165 for a lovely Beltex Gimmer Lamb. This consignment of knock out sheep went on to take the top three prices of the day, with the next pen of five going on to sell for £163 and their pen of ten selling for £161. The consignment from Well Head Farm saw 48 sheep sold selling to the top average at a whopping £146.76. The smaller type of sheep was easily sold throughout the whole sale with 25-30kg Blue type lambs selling between £130 and £155 regularly away. Topping the lighter sorts was Messrs Richardson, Low Garth, Bewaldeth, selling smaller types to a staggering £157.

Commercial type lambs also sold beyond all vendors expectations with a huge customer base ensuring all animals well sold and to the vendors' advantage.
