PRIME CATTLE – 23

Tuesday 12th March saw the 11th Anniversary Show and Sale of Prime Cattle with an exceptional run of meat throughout. The pre-sale show was judged by the well renowned Paul Harrison on behalf of RJ Harrison & Son, King Street, Wigton, who went on the place the following:-

The Overall Champion was awarded to Messrs Pearson, High Plasketlands, which later went on to sell for 320p/kg, weighing in at 654kg and resulting in a very respectable £2089.53.

The Reserve Champion was awarded to the 2nd prize Limousin Heifer from another strong weekly supporter, Messrs Dixon & Sons, Lesson Hall, which went on to top the days pence per kilo at a tremendous 326p/kg, resulting in £2005.08, both the Champion and Reserve Champion were purchased by the Judge Paul Harrison for his King Street Butchers Shop, Wigton.

Top gross of the day was achieved by Messrs JJ Crichton, Loughrigg with his lovely Limousin X Heifer, weighing in at 690kg and selling for 317.5p/kg, resulting in a top price of £2190.75. The same good farming also topped the Natives with a Galloway X Heifer, weighing in at 659kg and selling for 296p/kg, resulting in at £1947.35.

The Bulls returned a nice show, with WE Callion & Son, Lodge Farm sweeping the board, taking first and second in both Beef Prime Bull and Dairy Prime Bull, therefore resulting in him taking the Champion place with his Limousin Bull, weighing 824kg, selling to 293.5p/kg and reaching top gross price at £2418.44. The Reserve Champion place was secured by another Limousin Bull, weighing 704kg, selling to 290.5p/kg and grossing at

PRIME HOGGS – 1101

The 11th Anniversary Show and Sale of Prime Hoggs was very capably judged by Mr Steven Stoddart, Hillside, competing for the 'Robert Pigg Memorial Trophy', today's entry attracted 1101 Hoggs. With more forward to meet yet another rising trade with results proving dearer week on week, with an overall average of 415.87pkg and an SQQ of 422.83pkg. 35 pens of Hoggs in excess of 500pkg.

Master Judge today placed pen of 5 Hoggs, under 39kg as his Champions, which later went on to sell a top of 576.9pkg (£225) for RN Scott, West Micklethwaite, whose run of 27 Hoggs averaged a very creditable 510.34pkg or £202.60.

The Reserve Champion pen of 5 Hoggs went to W Robshaw, Beck House Farm, with his 39.1kg to 45.5kg pen, later selling to £219 per life, taking his average run of 33 to the top spot at £206.91 or 489.10pkg.

327 Beltex Hoggs 33-50kg averaged £188.17.

Straight commercial Hoggs forward in greater numbers trading between £165 and £185 for 42-46kg and a pen of 25

45.5kg Swaledales hitting top spot at £159.50 from Messrs Peile, Greystoke Castle Farm. Mules sold to £166.50 for WE & DE Litt, Greengill Farm, who also sold a pen of 15 Herdwicks to £171.50
