AUCTION REVIEW

We have had a very successful trading period here from the beginning of the year where we have continued to see new clients adding to the roster as numbers of stock reaches record levels for the period.

Strong growth in the prime sheep ring has seen the addition of new buyers complementing the operation and providing outstanding results for all classes and weights. Cull ewes continue to enhance vendors cheques, proving every week that strong results are

Store cattle sales continue at pace with a trade in a highly competitive market breaking the £3000 mark for feeding cattle on several occasions this spring. Wigton's reputation for providing thriving cattle continues to secure new clients and as a result throughput is growing year on year.

Store lambs through the autumn and spring have witnessed a sparkling trade topping at £200 for Dutch Texels with regular consignments £190 plus as trade hits a new high.

Dairy sales at Wigton continue apace with regular sales proving a success from both vendors and purchasers alike. The May Day Dairy Show and Sale is the most recent example of our facility with trade topping at £3150 for an Applejax heifer from How End Farms. Our Anniversary Show and Sale in March saw a similar trade with champion heifer from Gerrard House Farm peaking at £3250 for a strong 36kg Holstein Friesian heifer.

As Lambing Season comes to an end, ewes and lambs are trading with some ferocity as established buyers compete with cattle graziers who are struggling to source cattle. Numbers of units continue to improve year on year with £220 per life not uncommon for the better commercial units.

The prime cattle trade has been on the rise week on week, at the beginning of the year prices were reaching over £3/kg but in recent weeks £4/kg is more like it. We recently sold a Limousin Heifer from Messrs J Dixon & Son, Lesson Hall for a startling price of £4.90/kg. With a competitive ringside of buyers, new vendors are encouraged to bring cattle along to Hopes.

We would like to thank all our current customers for their continued support, we look forward to welcoming both new buyers and vendors here at Hopes Auction.

LAND AGENCY UPDATE

THE FARMING EQUIPMENT & TECHNOLOGY FUND 2025

There are 3 grants available to help buy equipment or technology to:

- Improve productivity
- Manage slurry
- Improve animal health and welfare

With a grant available between £1,000 and £25,000 for each category.

The application window is from the 29th May to midday on 10th July 2025, this will be the only application for 2025 so if you are interested please contact the Land Agency team to make sure you don't miss out!!

CAPITAL GRANT

In November 2024 DEFRA announced the temporary closure of the Capital Grant Scheme, they have been slowly processing all applications which were already in the system. The scheme is expected to reopen in "Summer 2025" however this will now have a spending cap limiting the amount you can apply for in each category:

- £25,000 for water quality (for example fencing, hardcore tracks, roofing over middens and silage clamps)
- £25,000 for air quality (for example automatic scrapers)
- £25,000 natural flood management (for example slowing water flow, storing water, improving soil infiltration)
- £35,000 for boundaries, trees and orchards (for example hedgerow works, drystone wall restoration)

It is understood that you will be able to apply in more than one category, but each SBI can only have one application per year with it expected to be a rolling application window. Some works including roofing, tracks and concrete require Catchment Sensitive Farming approval, get in touch for assistance with this and to get ready for the grant scheme reopening. PLANNING

SUSTAINABLE FARMING INCENTIVE (SFI)

The sudden closure of the SFI scheme has left many farmers in the dark. The scheme was closed with no prior warning and all applications halted. With the news of delinked payments being cut and ending in 2025, the SFI scheme was to offer essential financial assistance to farmers, so this closure has created further uncertainty for many farming businesses. The scheme offered flexibility for farmers to tailor an application to suit their needs and business operations. With the understanding this was a rolling application window and there was no rush to submit an application many farmers were carefully choosing options to best suit their business, inadvertently missing out on an opportunity to have a scheme submitted and a live scheme in place.

It is thought further details on the revised SFI scheme will be released following the Government's spending review in summer, with applications not being open until 2026. If an SFI is something which you are interested in, please contact us and once further details have been released we will be in touch.

IMPROVING FARM PRODUCTIVITY GRANT FOR ROBOT EQUIPMENT

We have been assisting businesses across the county with the Improving Farm Productivity Grant for Robotic Equipment. This grant is aimed to improve the farm productivity and efficiency where grant funding for 50% of the project is available. To date we have had 4 successful full applications for milking robots and slurry collectors, with several other applications submitted.
