Thanks to the Swainson Family who very kindly donated this Heifer to the MND Association. This fundraising event was further bolstered by the generosity of Keith Twentyman, who kindly donated 2 loader buckets selling for a combined total of £2500.

The Dairy Sale generated serial prices over the £3000 and the first prize Holstein Heifer from Orton Grange Farms which stood Reserve Champion, topped this tranche at £3300.
