The full sale from start to finish saw all Tups, shapes, sizes and breeds very good to sell, with strong Texel types best to sell with strength obviously best to sell.

Top price of the day was the third Tup in from Jack and Tom Peile, Greystoke Castle Farm, who had a packed pen right from the word go, topping the night at a staggering £2500, another pen mate making £2400, both Beltex crosses out of Pure Texel Ewes, with these pens later going on to average a whopping £1472.73 for 11 Tups sold.

Topping the averages was Kevin and Christine Wilson, Wood Farm, who consigned 6 massive Texel Tups full of ends topping out at £2000 and averaged the top of the night £1566.67 for 6 forward.

Another massive mention must go to Josh Merrall and Charlotte Wilson, Evening Hill, who topped out at £2100 with many more in the high teens of hundreds, selling 19 Tups to settle up at £1323.68.
